Hi Henrienne,

On March 5, 2021, the PDC Commission approved changes to the pending rules to incorporate additional stakeholder input for presentation to the Legislature. The two documents available here include the rejected sections and replacement sections for the pending rules.

- The [StrikeRejectApprovedforLegisReview20210305](#) document shows the rejected sections.
- The [TemporaryApprovedforLegisReview20210305](#) document shows the sections to replace the rejected sections.

The proposed changes that we are discussing in the negotiated rule making process are [IDAPA 61.01.01](#) and [IDAPA 61.01.02](#). We hope that you can take a look at those proposed changes to give us written input by this coming Monday, May 31, 2021. The Commission will review all stakeholder input, and then adopt proposed rules.

Those proposed rules will then be sent out to stakeholders for final comment during the August 13 and 16 public hearings, and we will request written input as well. I understand that the August 13, 2021 meeting is at the end of the Clerk's conference, so we specifically set an August 16 meeting in hopes that it would be a more convenient time for Clerks. I hope this is helpful. If it is not, or you need anything else, please let me know.
